## Why open an RDSP?

- The Registered Disability Savings Plan (RDSP) is a Canada-wide registered matched savings plan specific for people with disabilities.
- Some say it is the best return on investment available, an excellent long terms savings tool!
- It is a unique savings program that allows savings to grow in a tax-deferred environment and provides matching federal contributions of up to 300% annually for those eligible.
- For every \$1 put in an RDSP account for a child, the federal government can (if your family income is below \$91,831) match with up to \$3! This is the Canada Savings Grant.
- For people living on a low income (less than \$30,000), the federal government will put in \$1,000 each year for 20 years! This is the Canada Disability Savings Bond.
